➤ *Shock & Awe (total shift in mindset, leap from earth to heaven, gasp), "I get to walk with God today".*

- 1) *God, you are beyond my comprehension – you are amazing and you are holy. I worship you.*
- 2) *The Lord has made all things for himself. Prov 16:4 (God, I and everything else exist for your pleasure)*
- 3) *Yours, O LORD, is the greatness, the power, the glory, the victory, and the majesty. Everything in the heavens and on earth is yours, O LORD, and this is your kingdom. We adore you as the one who is over all things. 1Chrn29:11 There is no one holy like the LORD; there is no one besides you; 1Sam2:2*

Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.

"God, your kingdom is above all. It's the only thing that (you are building, lasts, is worthwhile, satisfies me). I want my life to serve your Kingdom rather than my own interests".

- 1) *He went on a little farther and bowed with his face to the ground, praying, "My Father! If it is possible, let this cup of suffering be taken away from me. Yet I want your will to be done, not mine." Matt 26:39 (God I want your will, regardless what that means. Pray for the work he's called you to)*
- 2) *Three different times I begged the Lord to take it away. Each time he said, "My grace is all you need. My power works best in weakness." 2 Cor12:8-9 (God your grace will be more than enough for me)*
- 3) *God, send me ONE person today to share your love with.*

Give us this day our daily bread

"Now that my priorities are right – God, give me all I need to be a blessing"

- 1) *Bring the full tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. And thereby put me to the test, says the LORD of hosts, if I will not open the windows of heaven for you and pour down for you a blessing until there is no more need. I will rebuke the devourer for you. Malachi 3:10-11*
- 2) *God, while your house is my priority, you promise to build and protect my house. I trust you.*
- 3) *God who takes care of me will supply all your needs from his glorious riches... Philippians 4:19*

Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us

"God, as I release others – please release me from the consequences of my sins and failures"

- 1) *You intended to harm me, but God intended it all for good. Gen 50:20 (God, thank you for all the good you intend and the growth you bring through _____)*
- 2) *Search me, God, and know my heart...See if there is any offensive way in me Psalm 139:2*
- 3) *If you forgive those who sin against you, your heavenly Father will forgive you. Matthew 6:14*

Lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from the evil one

➤ *"God - now that I'm free from all punishment, don't let me use my freedom to walk into a trap"*

- 1) *But Samson stayed in bed only until midnight (with prostitute). Then he got up, took hold of the doors of the town gate, including the two posts, and lifted them up, bar and all. He put them on his shoulders and carried them all the way to the top of the hill across from Hebron. ...he prayed, "Let me die with the Philistines." Judges 16:3 & 30 (God, give me strength to resist my old habits. continue to redeem me according to your will)*
- 2) *Now all glory to God, who is able to keep you from falling away and will bring you with great joy into his glorious presence without a single fault. Jude 1:24 (God, keep me from falling)*
- 3) *My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one. John 17:15 (God, heaven will come soon enough, use and protect me here for your glory)*
